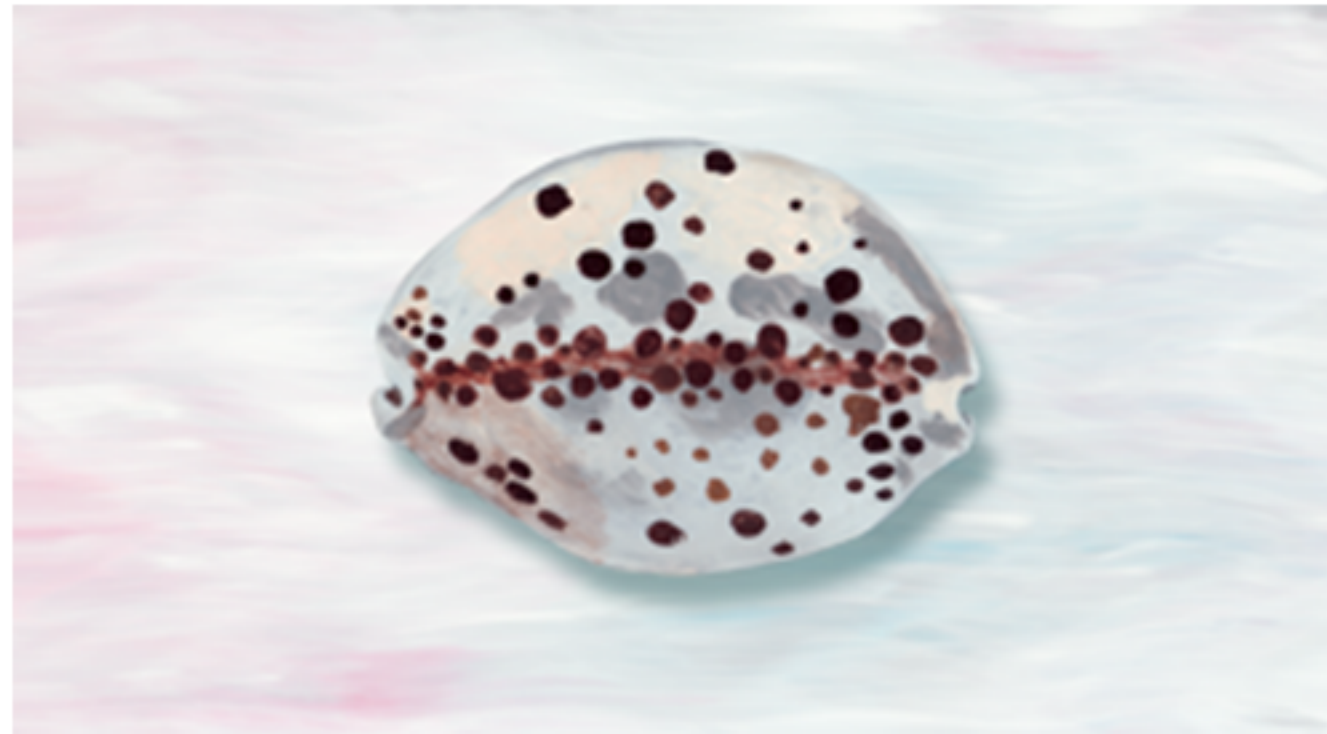




Ceramicist
